Paul Matejtschuk PhD CChem, is a Principal Scientist at the National Institute for Biological Standards & Control (NIBSC), UK, where his role is focused on the development of formulation and freeze drying conditions for a very wide range of biological reference materials. As well as 30 years experience in the formulation, characterisation and downstream processing of biologicals, Paul also has interests in the correlation of protein stability to formulation and in the application of thermal methods to freeze dried materials.
